Uniforms

Please take note of these uniform requirements.

Boys

- navy short pants to knee or long pants (elastic waistband allowed for elementary campus)
- hair must be short and neat
- no earrings

Girls

- navy short pants to knee, long pants, skirts to knee, or jumpers to knee
- hair must be neat and not distracting
- no visible undergarments

All students

- school polos (purchased in business office)
- closed-toed shoes (no crocs)
- *school jackets and hoodies (or navy)*
- hats are only for recess

School Expectations

We expect even our youngest students to abide by school rules that we believe will make everybody's school day more successful. Here are a few you can help your student prepare for.

- Do not run on campus (in the hallways, in and out of doors, and around corners).
- Never touch (tap, hit, rub, etc) or intentionally run into another student.
